Mainly Merlot but now with some Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot.

Very deep crimson. Very intense and ripe but with a Cab Franc-led fresh thread running through. Not as obviously Tuscan as this estate's other reds but there's a little Italian twist of light bitterness on the end. I wouldn't like this to be any riper ... but it's not gratuitously sweet or oaky.
