



The garden was born in 1932 thanks to Franco Venerosi Pesciolini who replaced the ancient orchard (pomaio) planted by the family at the end of the nineteenth century, designed according to medieval models, with a garden that he wanted realized according to the archetype of Italian gardens typical of the Renaissance . Surrounded by large holm oak trees, it stands out for its unusual trees, for examples of topiary art and for a magnificent green telescope made up of arched cypresses placed in the center of the garden, which leads the visitor's gaze straight onto a terracotta sculpture of the 19th century representing the goddess Pomona, in memory of the ancient orchard. The walk in the gallery of holm oaks and every corner of the garden is very suggestive, it spreads atmospheres of intimacy and romance.

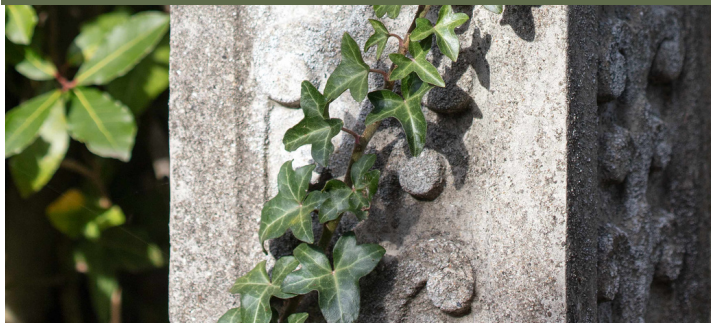
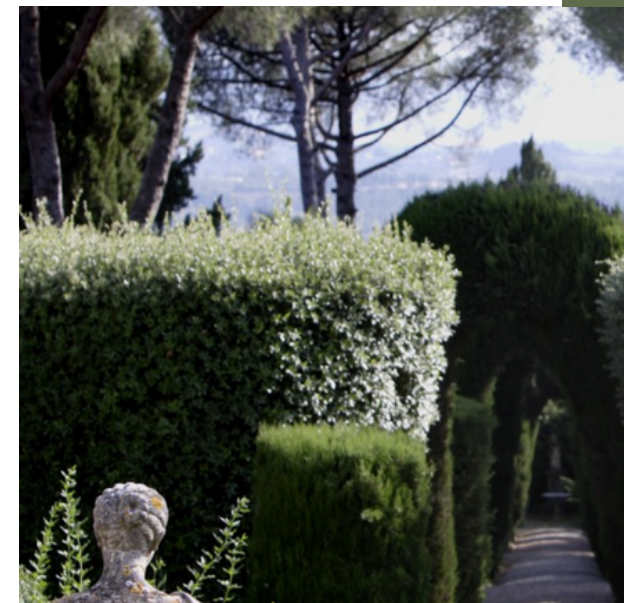
